## Project Update

### The City of Seattle is Making Progress on the Cleanup of Slip 4



Cleanup in Slip 4 on the Lower Duwamish Waterway is currently ahead of schedule and under budget!

The work, which began in October of this year, is expected to be complete in mid-February. Crews have completed removing contaminated soils from the bottom and banks of the slip and are now covering the remaining soils with a combination of clean sand, gravel, and rock to create an engineered cap over any remaining contamination. Crews are also demolishing an aging concrete pier to improve habitat.

The City has been and continues to work closely with EPA and the contractor to ensure there are no significant impacts on Tribal fishing or nearby communities and businesses.

The City has also monitored water quality in the slip throughout construction, and the results are good. Construction activities have not affected water quality; no monitoring limits have been exceeded.
